**Governor's Council on Impaired Driving**  
**April 27-29, 2004**  
**Meeting Minutes**

The quarterly meeting of the Governor's Council on Impaired Driving was held April 27-29, 2004 at the Radisson Hotel in Casper prior to and following the Governor's Conference on Impaired Driving. The meeting began with a luncheon and a welcome from Council Co-Chairs Debbie McLeland and John Holderegger who congratulated the Council members on both the quality and quantity of work accomplished during the Council's first 11 months.

Lorrie Pozarik and Kathy Gunderson provided Council members with final planning updates for the Governor's Conference including registrations, exhibitors, continuing education, awards banquet, and last minute program changes (Barb Watters, Mayor of Casper, will be stepping in for former Governor and Mrs. Sullivan to welcome attendees to the conference). Council members broke into workshop teams to review final plans for their sessions, set up and test equipment, and complete last minute problem solving.

Completed drafts of the Ignition Interlock and Child Endangerment white papers were reviewed. Several concerns were voiced over proposed language in the Child Endangerment white paper. Consensus was reached on several issues and, because of time constraints, the remaining issues were set aside for further discussion following the conference.

Most of the conference workshop speakers joined the Council for dinner. Conference speaker introductions were prepared and finalized.

The Governor's Conference on Impaired Driving was held on Wednesday, April 28, 2004. Two hundred five people attended the conference and/or Governor's Awards banquet.

The Governor's Council meeting resumed on Thursday morning following the conference. The conference evaluations were briefly reviewed (only 35 evaluation forms were returned to us) and a consensus was reached that the Governor's Council sponsor a statewide conference again next year. A proposal for funding the conference will be submitted to Highway Safety for consideration. Discussion also focused on agenda items for the next Council meeting in August. Council members would like to set priorities for legislative action, pending the Governor's approval of the various issues outlined in the white papers. Council policies and procedures will also need to be developed. Council members agreed to meet again the following week in Lander to complete the white papers for Governor Freudenthal.

A small group of Council members met on May 10, 2004 at the Central Wyoming College office in Lander to complete the review of the white papers. All four papers were edited, approved and distributed to all Council members for final comments. The papers were submitted to Julie Sapp who will review them with Governor Freudenthal. The Council expects to hear back from the Governor in time to plan the agenda for the August meeting.
